Fall 2012 Learning Community Offerings

2012-2013 Living-Learning Communities:

Sustainable Entrepreneurship Living-Learning Community
in Jefferson Suites

Open to first year and second year students majoring or minoring in Entrepreneurship, this community focuses on building and sustaining entrepreneurship in the local community.

Exploratory Studies Living-Learning Communities
in Reynolds Hall **

Open to first year students that may be undecided or considering more than one major. Students will "try-on" potential majors, while exploring their own interests and potential major choices.

Summer Launch Living-Learning Community
in Grogan Hall

Open to first year students who wish to explore the University and its resources early, this community serves as a Summer Bridge program that connects students with campus mentors and resources before classes start.

AToMs Living-Learning Community
Achieving Together in Mathematics and Science
in Reynolds Hall **

Open to first year students who are majoring in Chemistry, Computer Science, Mathematics or Physics. This community will feature upperclassmen mentors, focused study groups and fun.

The UNCG Global Village
in Phillip/Hawkins Halls

Open to first year students enrolled in German, French, Japanese, Russian or Spanish courses. Students will have a wonderful immersion experience exploring language and culture right where they live.

First-Year Experience (FYE) Living-Learning Community
in Reynolds Hall

FYE is open to all first-year students and fosters a close-knit community for students to share and to grow together. FYE offers social and educational opportunities throughout the year.

Leaders Emerging and Developing (LEAD) Living-Learning Community
in Cone Hall

The LEAD program provides students interested in leadership with the opportunity to live in a community full of emerging leaders who desire to learn about organizational development, ethics and global leadership.



Make a Difference House (MADH) Living-Learning Community
in Moore/Strong Halls

MADH is designed to help UNCG students become active citizens through service-learning, volunteerism, and personal responsibility.

Mosaic Living-Learning Community
in Phillips/Hawkins Halls

Mosaic is open to students of any major interested in expanding their understanding of social justice, multiculturalism, and global citizenship.

Spartan Wellness Living-Learning Community (female only)
in Weil/Winfeld Halls

Spartan Wellness Community is designed for first-year women who would like to develop and practice healthy habits within the residence halls in support of their overall personal wellness and academic success.

UNCG Teach Learning Community

Open to first year students majoring in education, this community focuses on preparing future educators for the classroom. Students explore topics such as the "hidden curriculum" and a variety of professional areas.

Rites of Passage Learning Community

Open to first year and transfer students, this community supports the educational and professional aspirations for male students from traditionally under-served populations.
