Moses Acquaah is working on curriculum forms to **add MGT375 on-line for Spring 2017.** Moses asked a faculty to review their course learning outcomes based on Bloom's Taxonomy.

Moses is also working on Form F for the **Management Concentration** to be reviewed and voted on at the October faculty meeting. You will find the working document on the N Drive.

Master's in International Business. Moses Acquaah and Vas Taras have a meeting scheduled with Bill Brown to discuss the Masters in International Business. Two students are helping develop the Master's in International Business for their senior honor project.

Moses Acquaah is the Champion for the **Ph.D. in Business Administration**, which will be a fee paying program.
