Planning & Faculty Development Committee

Joe Erba reported the committee's charge is to make recommendations to the Department Head on three items:

- 1. How professional development money should be distributed.
- 2. Telephone budget
- 3. Develop a Five-Year Strategic Plan for the Department of Management.

Professional development money will be distributed \$1,000 for tenure, tenure-track faculty and \$500 for non-tenure track faculty.

Joe Erba's GA researched how other departments have changed their phones. There were not pleased with the shared line approach. To reactivate a phone would be a \$80 charge/phone. Joe made a motion that no major changes be made. Seconded by Bill Tullar. This will be revisited next year, due to proposed budget cuts.

Joe Erba is on the Bryan School Five-Year Strategic Planning Committee. The Department Five-Year Strategic Plan needs to include a Management Major at the graduate level. The Department should not wait until the School level plan is finalized. The department plan should be developed concurrently. We need a plan in place for AACSB accreditation.

Annual Performance Review Process

The department's Intellectual Contributions document is unclear and should be revisited. The annual review forms may include a three page document on teaching, research and service. Please update your CV in Sedona. Forty-three (43) reports are pulled from Sedona.

Budget and Department Head

Concerning the 9% cut due to enrollment shortfall. Linda Brady was told "NO" to forgiving the debt. She is still waiting to hear if a payment plan of 2% / 3% / 4% will be accepted. Kevin Lowe will attend the Faculty Assembly in Chapel Hill on Friday. Hopefully, Tom Ross will address the budget cut for enrollment shortfall.

Kevin Lowe stated the Dean received three nominations for the Department Head position. Moses has an appointment scheduled with the Dean.

Curriculum Update
