Traditional Hall Grand Prize

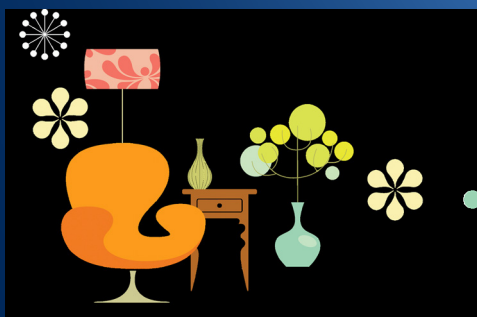

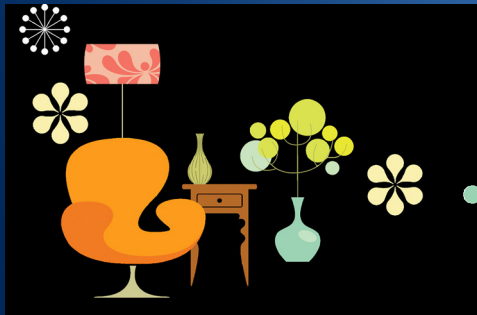

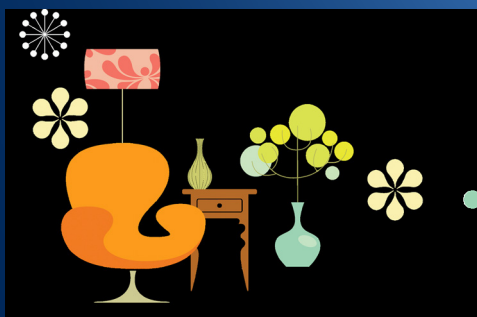
