

Program Committee members will be responsible for helping plan the annual dinner event in the spring, and to recommend, select and arrange for a speaker (usually done in conjunction with the full Board). Program committee members will also have input into other programs that the Friends might decide to have during the year and to aid in planning and executing those programs through service such as greeting guests. Program committee members are also invited to host programs and introduce speakers if they wish.

Book Discussion Group Committee members plan the book discussion group series for the year. They develop a theme, plan the discussions, arrange for discussion leaders, choose the books to be discussed, and promote participation in the groups. This committee is pretty well full for 2007 and has already met.

Fund-raising Committee members will work with UNCG Libraries and Development Office personnel to raise funds for the Libraries, make introductions and assist in making some calls on prospective donors whom they know.

Membership Development Committee members will recruit new members and encourage networking among the membership.

Marketing and Communications Committee members will help provide publicity for the Friends and for UNCG Libraries, seek sponsorship and co-sponsorship of events where appropriate, help distribute flyers and other information about events and advise the library administration on the proper marketing of the Friends of the Libraries organization. A particular project this year is likely to be the revision of the Friends of the Libraries informational brochure.
